GUIDELINES:

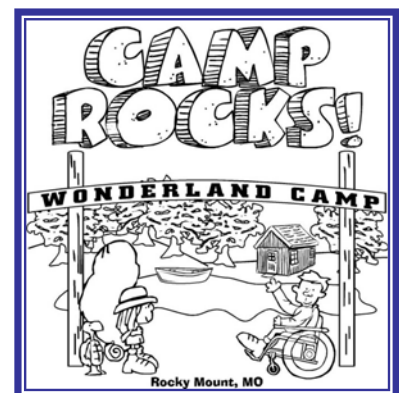
- 1) The logo must look good, large or small
- 2) They do not want people or silhouettes
- 3) They want something professional-looking with clean lines
- 4) They do not want something "cutesy."
- 5) It can be a picture, geometric shape, the words "Wonderland Camp" or just the letters "WC"...use your imagination.

RULES:

- 1) Only one submission accepted from each chapter
- 2) Each chapter that submits a logo will receive 5 POC points for 2nd Trimester (as long as it is submitted properly).
- 3) The chapter that has the winning submission will receive 30 POC points for 2nd Trimester (as long as it is submitted properly).
- 4) Submissions should be sent to me in order to qualify for the competition and for POC verification. Acceptable forms of entry include e-mail at bentontm@yahoo.com or mailed to Tonya Benton, 5160 N. Jasmine Way, Columbia, MO, 65202.
- 5) Deadline for submissions is an e-mail or postmark of August 1, 2006.
- 6) Submissions will be judged, and a winner selected, by the Wonderland Camp Board members at their August meeting.
- 7) All chapters who submitted an entry will be notified by September 1st of which logo won. The winner will also be announced at the Missouri Jaycees Fall Meeting in Joplin.
- 8) Wonderland Camp may or may not choose to use the winning submission.
- 9) All decisions are final.

CPG Book Judging at May State Meeting

Chapters are encouraged to put together some CPG Books from your 1st Period projects and bring the books to the May State Meeting for competition. This is how you get your outstanding projects and project chairpersons recognized at the state level. You're already running great projects, so finish the paperwork and get your people recognized for their hard work!!!

There is NO COST to submit project books for state judging, and you can submit as many books as you wish. Your chapter can also receive substantial POC points for submitting CPG books (up to 500 points per trimester!). Your CPG Project Books are also a valuable tool to be passed onto next year's chairperson to help them get started and make the project even more successful in year's to come.

This year, our judges will pay closer attention to each book to ensure that it's submitted in the proper format. CPG Books are quite easy to put together by following a few simple guidelines. Information on the Areas of Opportunities, guidelines for completing the CPG and rules for single project entries are all spelled out in the US Jaycees Awards Manual. http://www.usjaycees.org/Printable_Documents/O6AwardsManual.pdf

CPG Books that are submitted for judging at the May State Meeting that do not conform to the US Jaycees guidelines will NOT be judged and the chapter will not receive any POC credit for improperly formatted CPG Books! We appreciate the continuing help of the Missouri JCI Senate, as they provide Senator book judges for us at every state meeting. It's important that all books are formatted properly so the judges can focus on the content and the overall impact of the project and are able to make constructive suggestions on how to improve the books for year-end judging!

Please bring your CPG books with you to the May meeting and turn them in at the registration table no later than 10:00 PM on Friday night. The winners in each chapter division and overall will be recognized at the Sunday morning General Membership Meeting. If you have any questions, please contact me at the State Service Center.
