



Missouri Jaycees' Outstanding Young Missourian Nomination Form



PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Missouri Jaycees annually select and honor several Outstanding Young Missourians. A Jaycee chapter may submit one or more nominations for OYM honors. Young men and women of all fields of endeavor may be nominated. In determining the recipients of this recognition, the judges recognize outstanding achievements and community involvement, and give particular consideration to each nominee's record of adherence to the principles embodied in The Jaycee Creed. The overall winner will be eligible for nomination to represent Missouri in the National Ten Outstanding Young Americans competition.

NOMINATION RULES:

1. The age limit is 18-40. Applicants are not eligible if becoming 41 prior to January 1, 2021.
2. All chapters who submit a nomination must also submit an open check payable to the MISSOURI JAYCEES, to cover the cost of the nominee(s) registration, lodging and incidentals. The check must accompany this nomination form in order for the nomination to be considered. Chapters entering nominees who are not chosen as an honoree will have their checks voided and returned.

5. Summarize the nominee's most outstanding humanitarian efforts and how he/she exemplifies the line of the Jaycee Creed that states "Service to humanity is the best work of life".

INFORMATION SHEET FOR OUTSTANDING YOUNG MISSOURIANS COMPETITION

OVERVIEW:

Nominations for the Outstanding Young Missourians competition can be submitted by Jaycee chapters or individuals that know a deserving young achiever. The nominee must not be age 41 prior to January 1, 2021. The nominee must complete a nomination form due no later than August 1, 2020. If the applicant is selected as one of the honorees, he or she will be invited to attend the Missouri Jaycees' Outstanding Young Missourian's Awards Congress on January 15-17, 2021. The applicant will be asked to provide high-resolution photos, either on a CD, USB drive or by electronic submission, which may be used in the program guide and for a video presentation at the Awards Banquet.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

The Outstanding Young Missourian honorees are determined on the basis of achievement or contribution in any three (3) of the following areas

1. Personal improvement or accomplishments;
2. Financial success and economic innovation;
3. Social improvement to major contemporary problems;
4. Philanthropic contribution or voluntary service;
5. Politics or government service;
6. Scientific or technological contributions;
7. Legal reform;
8. Cultural achievement (to include contributions in literature, history, education or the arts);
9. Academic leadership or accomplishments;
10. Moral and religious leadership;
11. Athletic accomplishments;
12. Success in the influence of public opinion (news media and other means);
13. Any other important contributions to community, state or nation, at the discretion of the judges.

In determining the recipients of this recognition, the judges also give particular consideration to each nominee's record of adherence to the principles embodied in **The Jaycee Creed**:

WE BELIEVE:

*That faith in God gives meaning and purpose to human life;
That the brotherhood of man transcends the sovereignty of nations;
That economic justice can best be won by free men through free enterprise;
That government should be of laws rather than of men;
That earth's great treasure lies in human personality;
And that service to humanity is the best work of life.*

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OUTSTANDING YOUNG MISSOURIAN NOMINATION FORM GUIDELINES

The following information and guidelines are provided to help the applicant complete their Outstanding Young Missourian Nomination Form.

1. The application must be in typed format. The rules and instructions contained in this nomination form must be followed completely or the nomination will be automatically rejected.
2. Page 2 contains questions 1 through 5. Complete your answers to the five questions on no more than three 8.5" x 11" white sheets of paper (front side only) in a typed format. The allotted pages must have top, bottom and side margins of no less than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch. Do not use less than an 11 point font. Indicate the nominee's full name centered at the top of each page. Space used may vary for answering each question. Indicate by number where each answer begins. Single-spaced typewritten answers are preferred with a double space between paragraphs.
3. Respond to each question completely. Avoid using "does not apply" because everything applies. Don't feel that you must use all of the space provided, but make sure you cover all of the key points. Covering 4-6 key items fully is better than trying to cover 10-12 items and not explaining them fully and not doing them justice.
4. Your completed application is the only information the judges use for ranking. This is not a time to be humble. If possible, have a third-party critique your application before you submit it. You want to be certain that you have included your activities and achievements that exemplify you as one of our state's outstanding young leaders.
5. Where appropriate, quantify your responses. State facts and numbers wherever possible.

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
